



CHICKASHA FESTIVAL OF LIGHT & MUCH MORE TUESDAY, DECEMBER 6, 2017

- 12:00pm Depart from Putnam City Baptist Church, 11401 N. Rockwell, OKC on Red Carpet Van Hool Charter with kneeling entrance. Eat lunch before you come. You'll have a delicious included dinner.
- 1:00pm Tour the National Weather Center in Norman that combines the expertise of several different weather and atmospheric organizations that work together to improve understanding of events occurring in Earth's atmosphere over a wide range of time and space.
- 3:15pm Arrive at the Chisholm Trail Heritage Center in Duncan. The center includes the largest bronze sculpture in Oklahoma, which tells the complete story of the Chisholm Trail and is a winner of the Rosebud Award for outstanding tourist attraction.
- 4:30pm Dinner at El Palacio, a local favorite restaurant in Duncan with both American and Mexican choices from which to select.
- 6:00pm The Chickasha Festival of Light with more than 3.5 million lights. It has one of America's largest Christmas trees that is 16 stories or 172 feet tall with 25,000 lights, and the spectacular Crystal Bridge has 75,000 lights and more than 100 displays. You can get off the bus and walk across the bridge and enjoy the lights and sound of their synchronized light show and even enjoy a cinnamon roll if you wish. More than 300,000 visitors view these spectacular lights each year.
- 7:15pm Leave Chickasha to view some Christmas Lights in Oklahoma City area on the return trip.
- 8:30pm Approximate arrival back in OKC
